

Recycling and Waste Management: Tips for the French Quarter

HOW this can be easy and efficient for your business?

- 1. CLEAR SIGNAGE: It's important that all of your bins have clear signage with photos or examples of the types of materials that can be put in each bin.
- 2. ACCESSIBILITY: Recycling bins must be accessible to your staff where they work. Place bins in creative and strategic places and they don't have to be the traditional blue bin- get creative! If you don't have a place to put your bin outside, get creative and partner with another business who might be willing to share the costs.
- ACCOUNTABILITY: One person on your team must be in charge of waste management. This individual can help clarify the company's policy on recycling and monitor progress.

WHY should you do it?

- Recycling can save your business and our community money because it puts materials into use in our economy
- Work with your recycling service provider to help you lower your bill by reducing
 trash pickup and increasing your recycling. Note that as markets shift, the value
 of recyclables shift, and so will your billing. Also, recycling is not free. It still
 costs money to transport and sort materials, even if they are sold on the
 commodity market.
- Recycling creates jobs. Recycling and reuse create at least 9 times more jobs than landfills and incinerators, and as many as 30 times more jobs in the economy (http://www.ecocycle.org/zerowaste/jobs)
- Consumers and tourist expect recycling. Recycling improves your brand value
