Trucks over 36 feet are prohibited in the Vieux Carre, except "whenever it shall be necessary to transport a single article which cannot be divided and which exceeds the total weight, width, height, or length allowable." Sec. 154-1524

The above truck may be moved only on those streets and under those conditions referred to in Sections 154-1521, 154-1522, 154-1523, 154-1524, 154-1525, 164-1561, 154-1562, 154-156

This permit is effective on the above date(s) with the following restrictions:

- No truck over 36 feet delivering food and beverage is eligible for this permit except during Mardi Gras and a special event or Festival held in the Vieux Carre.
- Truck is to be used for maintenance, repairs, new construction of a building, or infrastructure in the Vieux Carre
- Truck will be used to transport commercial equipment to a hotel or business in the Vieux Carre
- A police escort may be required at the expense of the user.
- Trucks will move in "straight in and straight out" routes, with no corner turns at intersections, while in the interior of the Vieux Carre. If the truck is required to travel the wrong way on a one way street, an NOPD officer(s) will be required to provide street closures at the expense of the user.
- Interruption to businesses due to street closure, will be at the expense of the user.

It is understood that the applicant shall comply with the above Section of the City Code and all other provisions in this permit, and the applicant will take all precautions for the protection of lives and properties during the movement of the above equipment. The City of New Orleans accepts no liability for any incidents caused by the execution of this permit and may require a bond with good and solvent surety.

This permit becomes null and void if any City or State regulations are violated.
